

On the Spot Admission Days at MHS

What is “On the Spot Admission”?

- On the Spot Admission Days or High School Admit days are when a college admission representative comes to the high school to review applications in person. Students can sign up to meet one-on-one with an admissions representative for 10-15 minutes during the school day. The admissions rep will review your application, ask any needed questions and then give you an admissions decision (Some schools may not be able to directly admit students but will let you know the decision you are likely to get.)

What’s the benefit of participating?

- Waived application fees (save some money!)
- Find out right away if you’ve been accepted
- Great way to practice for future interviews
- Feedback. If a school is not able to accept you on the spot, you will know why, and can use this to improve your application. For example, the admissions rep may let you know that if you can bring your SAT score up 20 points, you would qualify for additional scholarships, or they may explain what you need to do to be directly admitted into the major you wanted.

What do I need to do participate?

- Complete an application 48 hours before your appointment time
- Sign up in the guidance office with Mrs. Cormier, space is limited!
- Specific details for each school will be given when you sign up
