## Week 1 – July 10-14

### Introduction to Creative Writing –Class Fee: \$259

Aspiring writers are encouraged to join us for this immersive summer experience. Like ENG 201, this course introduces students to elements of writing fiction, creative essays, and poetry.

### Introduction to Veterinary Science –Class Fee: \$269

Learn about the working world of veterinary technicians in this mash-up of VET courses (101, 110 and 125.) Topics explore the careers of veterinary team members, the nutritional needs and feeding of animals and pets, and animal nursing.

## Week 2 – July 17-21

### Introduction to Drawing –Class Fee: \$295

In this one week drawing class, students will learn how to compose with line, shape, tone, and color using traditional drawing materials. Inspired by YCCC's ART 120 college course, topics for this class will include visual perception, composition, and artists' materials.

### Introduction to Video Game Design –Class Fee \$259

This class is an exact copy of the game development class taught at YCCC! Students will learn the basics of 3D game design and level editing. Students will be introduced to the construction and implementation of their own textures and game assets for use in the game.

## Week 3 – July 24-28

### Character Animation –Class Fee \$259

Bring your own characters to life in this one week version of MUL 225. Students explore animating characters and creating personality in those characters, with a focus on sketching and development of objects and characters through storyboarding to actual models.

### Culinary Arts: Garde Manger –Class Fee: \$295

During this culinary arts class, students learn the art of Garde Manger. Similar to the college students in CUL 146, they study the preparation of salads and dressings, hors d'oeuvres and amuse-bouche, sandwich and egg dishes.

## Week 4 – July 31-Aug 4

### Photography and Photoshop –Class Fee: \$259

ART 136 is the inspiration for this photography course that will cover both taking and editing pictures. Students will need to bring their own digital cameras to class. Any type of digital camera can be used, but be sure to also bring the USB cord to transfer images to the computer.

### Criminal Investigation –Class Fee: \$200

Hone your forensic skills in this introduction to criminal investigation course. Modeled on YCCC's Criminal Justice course—CJS 240, students learn the procedures necessary for the proper handling of evidence. This class is taught by two detectives from the Wells Police Department.

## Week 5 – Aug 7-11

### Introduction to Architectural Design –Class Fee: \$259

Design your dream home in this introductory architecture course. Students are introduced to the architectural concepts taught in our ARC 106 and ARC 202 college courses, including space planning, architectural styles, building materials, and structural components.

### Culinary Arts: New World Cuisines –Class Fee: \$295

Students in this CUL 264 inspired class explore cooking techniques and preparations from across North and South America. Cuisines covered may include Cajun and Creole, Southern, New England, Mexican, Andean and Argentinian.
