GUIDANCE

JUNIORS: ACT registration deadline for the June 9, 2018, test date is May 4, 2018. Register at actstudent.org

JUNIORS: SAT/Subject Test registration deadline for the June 2, 2018, test date is May 3, 2018.

SENIORS: If you have been accepted to college and plan to enroll in the fall, **MAY 1st** is the traditional deadline colleges use for you to accept the offer of admission and to submit your deposit. Do not miss this deadline! It is also polite to send a short email or note to the colleges to which you were admitted and at which you have decided not to attend, notifying them of this decision and thanking them for their offer of acceptance. This could free up spots for other applicants who are on the waitlist.

Dual Enrollment: Are you a academically strong **sophomore or junior** student interested in taking a college course while still in high school? Now is the time to explore this idea. YCCC in Wells, ME, is the college where most MHS students take college courses, but it is possible to take a course at another college in Southern Maine. The cost, enrollment procedure, and requirements vary from college to college. Please speak with your guidance counselor to learn more about this Dual Enrollment option.

SENIORS: Filing the FAFSA is required for students who plan to pay for school with the help of federal, state or institutional financial aid. Students must file a FAFSA by **Tuesday, May 1** to be considered for the need based \$1,500 State of Maine Grant. Students, file your FAFSA now at **FAFSA.gov**. Having trouble with the FAFSA?
