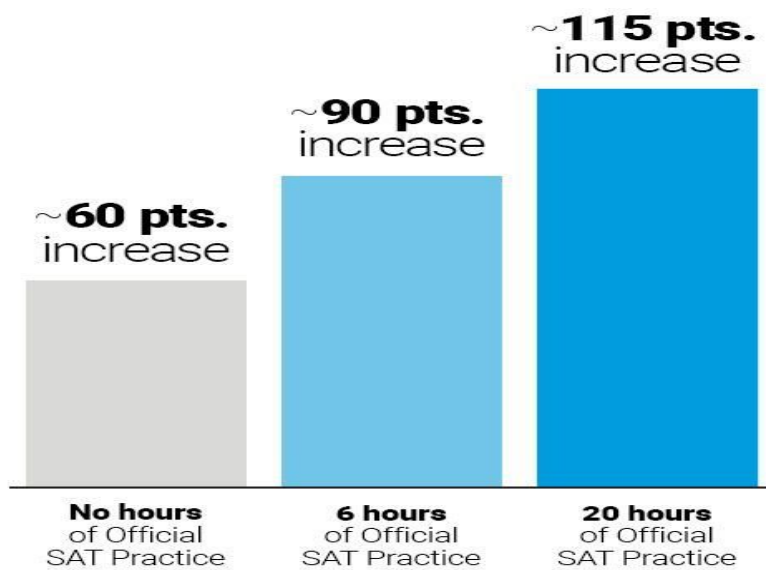

Dual Enrollment: Are you an academically strong **sophomore or junior** student interested in taking a college course while still in high school? Now is the time to explore this idea. YCCC in Wells, ME, is the college where most MHS students take college courses, but it is possible to take a course at another college in Southern Maine. The cost, enrollment procedure, and requirements vary from college to college. Please speak with your guidance counselor to learn more about this Dual Enrollment option.

Juniors: Planning to retake your SAT? Want to do better next time? Then log into your collegeboard account to go to Khan Academy to practice for your SAT. By joining Khan Academy SAT practice this way, the study work you are given will be individualized to your needs. Research has shown that students *on average* improve their scores with even small amounts of practice. The graphic below shows the average number of points gained on the SAT associated with the hours of practice on Khan Academy.
