RE: SAT Scores

It has come to my attention that SAT scores from the School Administered SAT are now posted on College Board (<https://www.collegeboard.org/>). Students need to have or make an account to get their scores. If you have already signed up for a College Board account, please use that same account to login.

Instructions to Access Scores

Student Access to Scores

1. Students will need a College Board account to view their scores.
2. Go to <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/viewscore> and log in.
3. Click sign up to register for an account if you don't already have one.

Please note: Some scores will be released later for reasons that may include participation in the accommodated testing window or on the makeup testing date, late receipt of answer sheets, missing information on the answer sheet, or other exceptional conditions that require additional attention.

If you sign into your College Board account but don't see scores, it means we were not able to link your score report and account automatically. For security reasons, a student must verify additional information before we can display scores. The student will need either his/her SAT registration number or the Student State ID number the student was pre-identified with by the school.

To match,

1. Go to <https://studentscores.collegeboard.org/viewscore>
2. Scroll down and click **Matching Tool**.
3. Review the personal information.
4. If any information is incorrect, click **Update** to revise. (Students will be prompted to re-enter their password.)
5. If the information is correct, click **Get My Scores**.
6. The student will have to select one of the following options:
 - a. I can supply my test information (test date and registration number), or
 - b. I can supply my student ID (using the student ID the student was pre-identified with – see guidance for the State Student Number)
7. Click **Get My Scores**.
